LOCAL LAW NO. 2-2012

A LOCAL LAW, TO AMEND LOCAL LAW 1-1993 KNOWN AS
“ADOPTION OF CODE”, ADOPTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF
WALES ON MAY 11, 1993, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 64, TERMS OF OFFICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

1. SECTION LEGISLATIVE INTENT

This Local Law amends a prior Local Law known as “Adoption of Code” adopted
by the Town of Wales on May 11, 1993, as amended, relating to the administrative,
legislative and general legislation of Codes within the Town of Wales as therein set forth.

SECTION 2. SECTION 64-1, TAX COLLECTOR

(Section 64-1 is deleted in its entirety, thereby deleting the office for the position
of Tax Collector.)

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York
Secretary of State.

A LOCAL LAW, TO AMEND LOCAL LAW 1-1993 KNOWN AS
"ADOPTION OF CODE", ADOPTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF
WALES ON MAY 11, 1993, BY AMENDING THE ENVIRONMENTAL
CONSERVATION ADVISORY COUNCIL IN REGARD TO ITS MEMBERSHIP.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

1. SECTION LEGISLATIVE INTENT

This Local Law amends a prior Local Law known as "Adoption of Code" adopted
by the Town of Wales on May 11, 1993, as amended, relating to the administrative,
legislative and general legislation of Codes within the Town of Wales as therein set forth.

SECTION 2. SECTION 16-2, MEMBERSHIP

Section 16-2 is amended to read as follows:

There shall be ~~(five)~~ members of the Council.

SECTION 3. SECTION 16-3, TERMS OF OFFICE

Section 16-3 is amended to read as follows:

The terms for Council members shall be for two years, with the terms of
(two) members to expire in one year and the terms of the other (three) ←
members in the next year.

SECTION 4. SECTION 16-4, APPOINTMENT

Section 16-4, Appointment, is enacted as follows:

The Town Board may appoint two members to the Council who are
between the ages of sixteen and twenty-one.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York
Secretary of State.
