This Public Hearing is for the Town of Wales Residents to provide their input to the Town Board concerning possible community development and housing projects which would benefit low to moderate income residents, elderly or handicapped residents and for the prevention of slums or blight in the Town of Wales.

Town Clerk then read published Notice of Public Hearing.

Supervisor Venditti stated that over the years we had different projects that benefitted from the Community Block Grant. Community center, front entrance made “accessible”, park shelter and walkway. Currently the Wales income levels do not qualify for any projects with low to moderate community block projects, but we can still apply for a grant. We always contribute, in conjunction, with Elma, Aurora, and Marilla for Rural Transit service; for transportation for our residents.
