**National Prescription Drug Take Back Day**  
**Saturday, October 23, 2021 - 10:00- 2:00 pm**

**National Take-Back Day is a safe, convenient, and responsible way to dispose of unused or expired prescription drugs. On Saturday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> from 10 am to 2 pm, there will be sites in Erie County and across Western New York set up for residents to dispose of expired, unused, and unwanted prescription drugs.**

Coordinated by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration, (DEA), this service is free and anonymous, no questions asked. Sites for the Drug Take Back Day are only able to accept pills and patches, sites for this event cannot accept liquids, needles, or sharps. Kiosks in Erie County accept other medication forms and sharps. The Elma Town Hall Kiosks can accept needles.
